Hi Rachael... Thanks much for the response as it's about that time in my life for a drastic change... I'm currently unemployed, on the last \$100 to my name, no employment in sight, although I've sent out 40 resumes since Christmas... I'm a Senior in the Bachelor's of Mental Health degree program at the University of Maine at Augusta. I am an excellent counselor and have worked with traumatized children (as well as sexually abused youngsters) who live in a locked residential mental healthy facility. At times I was required to physically restrain these kids (just giving you an idea as to the nature of that challenge)... Anyway, I'm now seeking work in that field but am encountering difficulties as I had an experience a few years back that will forever effect my identity and my ability to do the work I need to do... as a result of those experiences, I sought out CWG material in 2003, attended the CWG Retreat at the Gurney's September 04, have since attended many of Yahosheba's study groups in NYC (sometimes traveling the 6-7 hrs one way for a 3 hr meeting and then returning home that same day), have attended Christian's mini-retreat at Valerie Price's place last year and have begun to LIVE the word... it has become part of Who I Am now and I find myself teaching it to those in my life simply because I am passionate about it and that it has worked MIRACLES for me... it was my Godsend... bless Neale!! I have also found that those who interact with me learn something new about themselves, and me, with each experience... I embrace my interactions with people, positive or negative, because it's one more opportunity to continue creating who I want to be...

I find my self longing to teach this material in a structured forum to those who truly want to listen, learn, love, and live a truly happy life... and die a truly happy death... but doing that up here in Maine is a virtual impossibility as we Maineans don't like change or diversity. As you can see, I appear to be an exception to that rule. I do teach this material through living my life but people don't know they're learning... and there's something about my need for them to KNOW that they're learning... so, I typically make direct points about the material we talk about in such a way that they now have a new conscious perspective on an issue... for example, my friend and I were just the other day talking about Hurricane Katrina and all those who lost their possessions as a result... he was talking about how devastating that has been for those millions of people... but, Me being Me, I couldn't restrain my Self from pointing out that it was Life's way of showing those millions of people what is TRULY important on this earth... they lost every material possession, notwithstanding the clothes on their backs, but they still have their LIVES and their CHARACTER... and some still have their families intact... and many of them love Life ever more than could have ever imagined... what a gift!! He was able to put his opinion aside and see that my perspective had a softer air about it and provoked peace instead of anxiety and fear...

I dunno, Rachael, I could go on and on and tell you about all the wonderful, loving, positive affects I have had on all those who have crossed my path since I discovered CWG. I am a Natural Teacher (as well as a Natural Student) and I crave teaching opportunities... however, I have one HUGE obstacle that prevents me from doing what I need to do...

I have no money to invest in the LEP programs... nor can I currently afford to make payment arrangements (well, not arrangements that would require payments begin immediately)... I am actively seeking work but would rather work for the CWG Foundation. I am a single woman with no concrete ties to my community which would prevent me from traveling, or even relocating... I have seriously considered relocating to a more southerly (warmer) area but am once again burdened by the financial constraints in my life. I know the CWG Foundation is also straddled with limited revenue so employment opportunities are restricted, at best... However, if the Foundation was able to Mentor me, I would prove (almost immediately) what an asset I could (and would) be for the foundation and our fellow souls...

I know this sounds all so melodramatic, but I am being absolutely genuine, and honest, with you about Who I Am, and what effects I could have as a result of yours and my communication, and the help of the Foundation... I am so hoping that we can be creative and resourceful and create something that works for all involved.

Please give me a call so we can figure something out...
