Here are some pics of our new place... its an old, funky house that has a lot of Maine backwoods charm... the house is umbrella'd by a HUGE eucalyptus tree being at least 150+/- ft back from the road, our yard is completely fenced in and it has off-street parking, although we are just about in the heart of downtown Walnut Creek... it is only a 5 min. walk to the subway station as well as a 5 min. drive to the freeway ramps... also, because of the weather pattern out here electricity and gas bills are miniscule, especially for a house like this one that also has a working wood fireplace... we can just build a small fire to take the chill off, which is usually all it is when temps get no cooler than 50degrees... the rooms are smallish but they're workable especially since there is much more living space than just the typical standard rooms... there are many nooks, crannies and cubbyholes that we are going to make very good use of, both inside and outside of the house... there's at least 2 exterior "patio" type structures, one being covered and the other not... its going to be a lot of fun... the landlord has said that i can paint, wallpaper or do anything I wish to the house to make it my home... he has already offered to get paint for us and has already started gathering some necessary furniture that he knows he has kickin around at his other rental places... beds, mattresses, microwave, fridge, new washer/dryer, etc. etc etc... people out here are so polite, courteous and most of them go out of their way to help their peers... its absolutely amazing!! I cant believe how blessed we are to have found this place...
