When I found out yesterday that Dad left everything he owns to Raye and didn't even mention Joe and I in his Last Will, I was shocked speechless.

I cannot understand how Dad could ignore his children in his Last Will even if it was just to tell us he loved us.

I have struggled my entire life with the way Dad has chosen to behave. I came back into his life on his birthday last year to try to repair whatever can be repaired and now I find out my efforts were futile. He chose not to think of his children when he was making his final plans and I don't know how to deal with that.

As I said to Raye, it's not about having his things; it's about him being thoughtful toward his children in his Last Will which he chose not to do. And now he's gone and I have to live with that for the rest of my life. On top of that, adding more insult to injury, when Raye dies her 4 children will inherit everything Dad left to her so Joe and I will lose twice.

I am feeling so hurt right now that I cannot possibly write his eulogy or participate in his funeral service.

And I feel like such a fool.

I'm sorry to be the bearer of more bad news, but life sucks sometimes,
