Because of my exhaustive research, comprehensive investigation, analytical skills, and writing skills, Mr. Redman has at least a 50% chance or better of overcoming the statute of limitations hurdle and winning the entire lawsuit in a summary judgment proceeding. It's a fascinating complaint that is attached here for you as a sample of my research, analytical skills, and my refined legal writing.


